contains the main strategic objectives in the field of scientific research and innovation

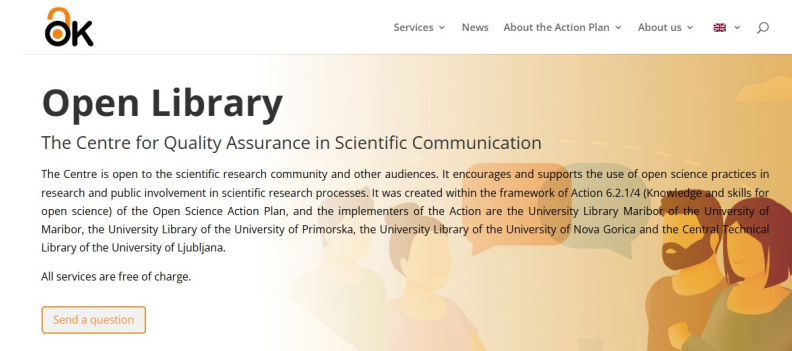



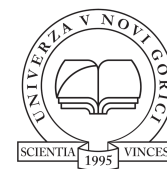
